

LUNG PRABANG-VIENTINE-SIEM REAP (6 Nights 7 Days)

Day 1: ARRIVAL LUANG PRABANG

(D)

- Upon arrival at Luang Prabang airport, you are met and transferred to the hotel.
- Luang Prabang is perhaps the best-preserved traditional city in Southeast Asia. The tranquility and charm of this town with its splendid natural scenery and cultural sights make it one of the most delightful places to visit in Laos. After a short rest, we can explore Luang Prabang city by their own activities.
- Dinner will be served at Hotel.
- Accommodation in Luang Prabang.



Day 2: LUANG PRABANG-PAKOU CAVE – CITY TOUR

(B, L, D)



- After breakfast, we enjoy a short-guided tour seeing the city's oldest temple of Wat Sene and the magnificent Wat Xiengthong with its roofs sweeping low to the ground, which represent the classical architecture of Luang Prabang temple. We then board a cruise upstream on the Mekong River, which also gives us a beautiful view of the tranquil countryside as well as an interesting visit to the mysterious of Pak Ou Caves, crammed with thousands of gold lacquered Buddha statues of various shapes and sizes. Along the way, we stop at the village of Ban Xanghai, where they make the distillation of local rice wine. On return, we take a short drive to Ban Phanom, well known for its hand weaving. We then climb up to the top of Phousi Mount for an enjoyable exploration of the sacred, gilded stupa as well as a beautiful sunset view of the city and the Mekong River.

From there, we explore Street Night Bazaar, where you can find the lovely collection and handmade textile by local and hill tribe people surrounding Luang Prabang.

- Dinner at local restaurant
- Accommodation in Luang Prabang.

Day 3: LUANG PRABANG – VIENTIANE

(B, L, D)

- After breakfast visit The National Museum at the former Royal Palace, which displays a lovely collection of the artifacts reflecting the richness of Lao culture dating from the days of the early kings right through the last sovereign, and the Central Market are not to be missed.
- After that transfer to Airport for flight to Vientiane. On arrival at Vientiane, transfer to hotel. We see the major sights of the capital; including the oldest Wat Sisaket, the temple with thousands of miniature Buddha statues and the former royal temple of Wat Prakeo, which previously housed the famous Emerald Buddha Image. On the way to Lao's national precious heritage, the famous and sacred structure of That Luang Stupa,



we stop enroute to take some pictures of the imposing Patuxay Monument, which is well known as Vientiane's own Arc de Triumph. We watch the sunset by Mekong Riverside and spend the evening here absorbing the city's nightlife

- Dinner at local restaurant
- Accommodation in Vientiane.

Day 4: VIENTIANE CITY TOUR – SIEM REAP

(B, L, D)

- Breakfast at hotel
- Early morning, you will be transferred to airport for board a flight to Siem Reap
- Upon arrival at airport, you will be met and welcome by your tours guide in Siem Reap and transfer hotel for relaxing till Lunch time.



- Lunch at local restaurant
- Afternoon, visit **Angkor wat**, the most balanced, the most harmonious, and the most perfect Khmer temple. It shows Khmer art, which reached the height of it glory in the 12th century. The temple is a temple-mountain and was built by king Suryavrmn II.
- Climb **Bakheng hill** to have bird's-eye view of sunset, Angkor Wat and western Baray.
- Dinner at local restaurant.
- Accommodation in Siem Reap.

DAY 5: BIG & SMALL CIRCUIT

(B, L, D)

- Breakfast at hotel
- Visit **Prasat Kravan**, a brick temple built in 10th century, **Srah Srang** (royal bath), **Banteay Kdei**, and a Buddhist monastic complex built in 12th century. Then visit an amazing view of **Ta prohm** Temple which has been deliberately left as it was discovered. In Ta Prohm kapok trees clasp the sanctuaries in their mighty roots; and **Ta Keo** - an unfinished state temple for unknown reason. Ta Keo temple was built in early 11th century by King Jayavarman V and dedicated to god Shiva.



- Lunch at local restaurant.
- Afternoon, visit **Pre Rup** temple, a classic example of temple-mountain, and the last without continuous galleries; **Eastern Mebon**, **Ta som**, **Neak Pean**, a unique ancient hospital built in the reign of king Jayavarman VI (1181-1220) which has been seen as a representation of Anavatapta, a miraculous lake in Himalayas that cures all illnesses; and **Preah Khan**, a large temple built on the site of battle that ended in Ankor's downfall at the land of the Cham. Preah Khan was also really a kind of university, housing a number of masters and students.
- Dinner at local restaurant
- Accommodation in Siem Reap.

DAY 6: BANTEAY SREI – FLOATING VILLAGE

(B, L, D)

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Visit **Banteay Srei** Temple, a tiny temple complex consider by many visitors to be the highest achievement in art and architecture of the Classic Angkor civilization. The glory of Banteay Srei is the beauty of its sculpture and decoration. The pink sandstone used in its buildings makes this temple more beautiful. On the way back to the town you will visit **Banteay Samre**, Built in 12th in Angkor wat stile.
- Lunch at local restaurant
- Visit **floating village** on **Tonle Sap Lake**, a biggest fresh water lake in south-east Asia. Most people (90%) are fishermen living in their wooden houses built on small boats and rafts. Because of flood during rainy season they move their houses many times a year depending on water level.
- Dinner at **with traditional show** local Restaurant.
- Accommodation in Siem Reapl.



DAY 7: DEPARTURE

(B)

- Breakfast at hotel
- Free at own leisure
- Transfer to Siem Reap airport and **end of services**
