

## LUNG PRABANG-VIENTINE-PHNUM PENH-SIEM REAP (7 Nights 8 Days)

### Day 1: ARRIVAL LUANG PRABANG

(D)

- Upon arrival at Luang Prabang airport, you are met and transferred to the hotel.
- Luang Prabang is perhaps the best-preserved traditional city in Southeast Asia. The tranquility and charm of this town with its splendid natural scenery and cultural sights make it one of the most delightful places to visit in Laos. After a short rest, we can explore Luang Prabang city by their own activities
- Dinner will be served at Hotel.
- Accommodation in the hotel.



### Day 2: LUANG PRABANG-PAKOU CAVE – CITY TOUR

(B, L, D)



- After breakfast, we enjoy a short-guided tour seeing the city's oldest temple of Wat Sene and the magnificent Wat Xiengthong with its roofs sweeping low to the ground, which represent the classical architecture of Luang Prabang temple. We then board a cruise upstream on the Mekong River, which also gives us a beautiful view of the tranquil countryside as well as an interesting visit to the mysterious of Pak Ou Caves, crammed with thousands of gold lacquered Buddha statues of various shapes and sizes. Along the way, we stop at the village of Ban Xanghai , where they make the distillation of local rice wine. On return, we take a short drive to Ban Phanom , well known for its hand weaving. We then climb up to the top of Phousi Mount for an enjoyable exploration of the sacred, gilded stupa as well as a beautiful sunset view of the city and the

Mekong River. From there, we explore Street Night Bazaar, where you can find the lovely collection and handmade textile by local and hill tribe people surrounding Luang Prabang.

- Accommodation in Luang Prabang

### Day 3: LUANG PRABANG – VIENTIANE

(B, L, D)

- After breakfast visit The National Museum at the former Royal Palace , which displays a lovely collection of the artifacts reflecting the richness of Lao culture dating from the days of the early kings right through the last sovereign, and the Central Market are not to be missed.
- After that transfer to Airport for flight to Vientiane. On arrival at Vientiane, transfer to hotel. , we see the major sights of the capital; including the oldest Wat Sisaket, the temple with thousands of miniature Buddha statues and the former royal temple of Wat Prakeo, which previously



housed the famous Emerald Buddha Image. On the way to Lao's national precious heritage, the famous and sacred structure of That Luang Stupa, we stop enroute to take some pictures of the imposing Patuxay Monument, which is well known as Vientiane's own Arc de Triumph. We watch the sunset by Mekong Riverside and spend the evening here absorbing the city's nightlife

- Dinner at local restaurant
- Accommodation in Vientiane.

**Day 4: VIENTIANE CITY TOUR – PHNOM PENH**

**(B, D)**



- Breakfast at hotel
- After breakfast, you will be transferred to airport for board a flight to Phnom Penh.
- Upon arrival at airport, you will be met and welcome by your tours guide in Phnom Penh and transfer hotel for relaxing.
- Start a city tour of some major sights of Phnom Penh. You will visit the **National Museum**, in which there is an attractive collection of ancient Khmer art: The sandstone sculptures dating from both the Angkorean and pre-Angkorean eras. You will also visit **Royal Palace**, the sacred **Silver Pagoda**, which is well known for its 5000 silver tiled floor. Heading out of this area. You will follow your trip to **Wat Phnom**.
- **Dinner** at Local Restaurant.
- Accommodation in Phnom Penh.

**Day 5: VISIT PHNOM PENH**

**(B, L, D)**

- Breakfast at hotel
- After breakfast, you will exploring the capital city with the bustling Central Market, the Independence Monument, Wat Ounalom.
- Lunch at local restaurant
- Then we continue our trip to the Tuol Sleng Prison Museum and the notorious " Killing Fields" of Choeung Ek, which provides a deep insight into the painful rule of the Khmer Rouge
- Dinner at Local restaurant.
- Accommodation in Phnom Penh.



**Day 6: PHNOM PENH - SIEM REAP**

**(B, D)**

- Breakfast at hotel
- You will be transferred to airport for departure to Siem Reap.
- Upon arrival Siem Reap, you will be welcomed by our tour guide and transferred to the hotel.
- Afternoon, Visit **Roluos Group**, dating from the late ninth century. In Roluos Group you will visit three temples: **Bakong**, the first *temple-mountain* in Khmer architecture initiated by Jayavarman II on his descent from Kulen hill; **Preh Ko**,



which means in Khmer “The sacred ox”, the funerary of Jayavarman II and of the ancestors of his second successor, Indravarman; **Lolei**, the last brick temple in the group located on an island in the middle of the Indratataka - a large ancient reservoir.

- Dinner at local restaurant.
- Accommodation in Siem Reap.

**Day 7: VISIT ANGKOR WAT - INSIDE ANGKOR THOM**

**(B, L, D)**



- Breakfast at hotel
- Visit **Angkor wat**, the most balanced, the most harmonious, and the most perfect Khmer temple. It shows Khmer art, which reached the height of its glory in the 12<sup>th</sup> century. The temple was built by king Suryavrmn II and dedicated to god Vishnu.
- Lunch at local restaurant.
- Afternoon, visit **south gate of Angkor Thom** with two rows of its huge statues of demons and gods depicting the churning of the ocean of milk arranged on both sides of stone bridge and **Bayon** temple, a

forest of heads, built in late of 12th century by king Jayavarman VI as a Buddhist state temple. Then, visit **terrace of elephant**, which used to be a base for the king's grand audience hall; **Terrace of Leper king** supposed that it was a terrace housed the royal crematory.

- Climb **Bakheng hill** to have bird's-eye view of sunset, Angkor Wat and western Baray.
- Dinner **with traditional show** at local restaurant
- Accommodation in Siem Reap.

**Day 8: VISIT FLOATING VILLAGE**

**(B, L)**

- Breakfast at hotel
- Visit **floating village** on **Tonle Sap Lake**, a biggest fresh water lake in south-east Asia. Most people (90%) are fishermen living in their wooden houses built on small boats and rafts. Because of flood during rainy season they move their houses many times a year depending on water level.
- Lunch at the restaurant.
- **Service end** after transfer to airport for departure.
