

LUNG PRABANG-VIENTINE-PHNOM PENH (5 Nights 6 Days)

Day 1: ARRIVAL LUANG PRABANG

(D)

- Upon arrival at Luang Prabang airport, you are met and transferred to the hotel.
- Luang Prabang is perhaps the best-preserved traditional city in Southeast Asia. The tranquility and charm of this town with its splendid natural scenery and cultural sights make it one of the most delightful places to visit in Laos. After a short rest, we can explore Luang Prabang city by their own activities
- Dinner will be served at Hotel.
- Accommodation in the hotel.



Day 2: LUANG PRABANG-PAKOU CAVE – CITY TOUR

(B, L, D)



- After breakfast, we enjoy a short-guided tour seeing the city's oldest temple of Wat Sene and the magnificent Wat Xiengthong with its roofs sweeping low to the ground, which represent the classical architecture of Luang Prabang temple. We then board a cruise upstream on the Mekong River, which also gives us a beautiful view of the tranquil countryside as well as an interesting visit to the mysterious of Pak Ou Caves, crammed with thousands of gold lacquered Buddha statues of various shapes and sizes. Along the way, we stop at the village of Ban Xanghai , where they make the distillation of local rice wine. On return, we take a short drive to Ban Phanom , well known for its hand weaving. We then climb up to the top of Phousi Mount for an enjoyable exploration of the sacred, gilded stupa as well as a beautiful sunset view of the city and the

Mekong River. From there, we explore Street Night Bazaar, where you can find the lovely collection and handmade textile by local and hill tribe people surrounding Luang Prabang.

Day 3: LUANG PRABANG – VIENTIANE

(B, L, D)

- After breakfast visit The National Museum at the former Royal Palace , which displays a lovely collection of the artifacts reflecting the richness of Lao culture dating from the days of the early kings right through the last sovereign, and the Central Market are not to be missed.
- After that transfer to Airport for flight to Vientiane. On arrival at Vientiane, transfer to hotel. Then, we see the major sights of the capital; including the oldest Wat Sisaket, the temple with thousands of miniature Buddha statues and the former royal temple



of Wat Prakeo, which previously housed the famous Emerald Buddha Image. On the way to Lao's national precious heritage, the famous and sacred structure of That Luang Stupa, we stop enroute to take some pictures of the imposing Patuxay Monument, which is well known as Vientiane's own Arc de Triumph. We watch the sunset by Mekong Riverside and spend the evening here absorbing the city's nightlife

- Accommodation in Vientiane.

Day 4: VIENTIANE CITY TOUR – PHNOM PENH

(B, D)

- Breakfast at hotel
- After breakfast, you will be transferred to airport for board a flight to Phnom Penh.
- Upon arrival at airport, you will be met and welcome by your tours guide in Phnom Penh and transfer hotel for relaxing.
- Start a city tour of some major sights of Phnom Penh. You will visit the **National Museum**, in which there is an attractive collection of ancient Khmer art: The sandstone sculptures dating from both the Angkorean and pre-Angkorean eras. You will also visit **Royal Palace**, the sacred **Silver Pagoda**, which is well known for its 5000 silver tiled floor. Heading out of this area. You will follow your trip to **Wat Phnom**.

Day 5: VISIT PHNOM PENH

DAY 6: VISIT RUSSIAN MARKET – DEPARTURE

- Visit Royal University of Fine Arts where the young Cambodians learn the ancient arts of their ancestors. The most interesting part of this structure is the Dance Academy. Then we continue to one of the city's lively open markets, Psar Toul Tom Pong or Russian Market, where everything is for sales.
- Lunch at local restaurant
- **Service end** after transferred to airport for departure.
