

## SAIGON - SIEM REAP

### Day 1: ARRIVAL - SAIGON

- On arrival at Saigon's Tan Son Nhat International airport, you will be greeted by our guide and transferred to your hotel in Hanoi.
- Free to leisure.
- Overnight in Saigon.



### Day 2: EXCURSION SAIGON – CU CHI

(B, L, D)



- Breakfast at the hotel.
- In the morning, take a Saigon city tour: Reunification Palace, War Museum of Remnant, Notre Dame Cathedral, city Postoffice, shopping at Ben Thanh market.
- Lunch at local restaurant.
- Afternoon, travel to Cu Chi, famed for its 200-kilometre-long tunnels.
- Return to Saigon.
- Dinner and Overnight in Saigon.

### Day 3: SAIGON – VUNG TAU

(B, L, D)

- 08h00: Depart for Vung Tau, known under the French as Cap Saint Jacques, is famous seaside resort on the East Sea. Spend your time for swimming.
- Lunch at local restaurant. Free at leisure.
- Return to Saigon.
- Other option: P/U at hotel. Enjoy a full-day excursion to My Tho, a peaceful town on the bank of Mekong River. The tour comprises a cruise on the Mekong River, a visit to orchards and local homes, a sampan ride on palm-shaded creeks, a taste of seasonal fruits and honey tea and a performance of traditional Southern singing.
- Return to Saigon. Dinner and O/N in Saigon



### Day 4: SAIGON – SIEM REAP

(B, D)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Free leisure.
- Transfer to Airport for departure to Siem Reap.
- Upon arrival Siem Reap International Airport, you will welcome by Tour guide in Siem Reap and transfer to hotel.
- Dinner and Overnight in Siem Reap.

### DAY 5: ANGKOR WAT - ANGKOR THOM

(B, L, D)

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Visit Angkor wat, the most balanced, the most harmonious, and the most perfect Khmer temple. It shows Khmer art, which reached the height of its glory in the 12<sup>th</sup> century. The temple is a temple-mountain and was built by king Suryavman II and dedicated to god Vishnu.
- Lunch at local restaurant.
- Afternoon, visit south gate of Angkor Thom with two rows of its huge statues of demons and gods depicting the churning of the



ocean of milk arranged on both sides of stone bridge and Bayon temple, a forest of heads, built in late of 12th century by king Jayavarman VI as a Buddhist state temple. Then, visit terrace of elephant, which used to be a base for the king's grand audience hall; Terrace of Leper king supposed that it was a terrace housed the royal crematory.

- Climb Bakheng hill to have bird's-eye view of sunset, Angkor Wat and western Baray.
- Dinner at Local Restaurant.
- Overnight in Siem Reap

**DAY 6: BANTEAY SREI – BIG CIRCUITE**

**(B, L, D)**



- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit Banteay Srei Temple, a tiny temple complex considered by many visitors to be the highest achievement in art and architecture of the Classic Angkor civilization. The glory of Banteay Srei is the beauty of its sculpture and decoration. The pink sandstone used in its buildings makes this temple more beautiful. On the way back to the town you will visit Banteay Samre, Built in 12<sup>th</sup> in Angkor wat style.
- Lunch at local restaurant
- Afternoon, visit Pre Rup temple, a classic example of temple-mountain, and the last without continuous galleries; Eastern Mebon, Ta som, Neak Pean, a unique ancient hospital built in

the reign of king Jayavarman VI (1181-1220) which has been seen as a representation of Anavatapta, a miraculous lake in Himalayas that cures all illnesses; and Preah Khan, a large temple built on the site of battle that ended in Ankor's downfall at the land of the Cham. Preah Khan was also really a kind of university, housing a number of masters and students. Then visit an amazing view of Ta prohm Temple which has been deliberately left as it was discovered.

- Dinner with traditional show at local restaurant.
- Overnight in Siem Reap.

**Day 7: FLOATING VILLAGE - DEPARTURE**

**(B)**

- **Breakfast** in the hotel.
- Visit **floating village** on **Tonle Sap Lake**, a biggest fresh water lake in south-east Asia. Most people (90%) are fishermen living in their wooden houses built on small boats and rafts. Because of flood during rainy season they move their houses many times a year depending on water level.
- Transfer to airport for departure. **End of Services.**
