

## SAIGON - SIEM REAP – PHNOM PENH

### Day 1: ARRIVAL - SAIGON

- On arrival at Saigon's Tan Son Nhat International airport, you will be greeted by our guide and transferred to your hotel in Hanoi.
- Free to leisure.
- Accommodation in Saigon.

### Day 2: EXCURSION SAIGON – CU CHI

(B, L, D)

- **Breakfast** in the hotel.
- In the morning, take a Saigon city tour: Reunification Palace, War Museum of Remnant, Notre Dame Cathedral, city Post office, shopping at Ben Thanh market.
- Lunch at local restaurant.
- Afternoon, travel to Cu Chi, famed for its 200-kilometre-long tunnels.
- Return to Saigon.
- Dinner and Overnight in Saigon.



### Day 3: SAIGON – VUNG TAU

(B, L, D)



- 08h00: Depart for Vung Tau, known under the French as Cap Saint Jacques, is famous seaside resort on the East Sea. Spend your time for seabath.
- Lunch at local restaurant. Free at leisure.
- Return to Saigon.
- Other option: P/U at hotel. Enjoy a full-day excursion to My Tho, a peaceful town on the bank of Mekong River. The tour comprises a cruise on the Mekong River, a visit to orchards and local homes, a sampan ride on palm-shaded creeks, a taste of seasonal fruits and honey tea and a performance of traditional Southern singing.

- Return to Saigon. Dinner and O/N in Saigon

### Day 4: SAIGON – SIEM REAP

(B, D)

- **Breakfast** in the hotel.
- Free leisure.
- Transfer to Airport for departure to Siem Reap.
- Upon arrival Siem Reap International Airport, you will welcome by Tour guide in Siem Reap and transfer to hotel.
- **Dinner** and Overnight in Siem Reap.

**DAY 5: ANGKOR WAT - ANGKOR THOM**

**(B, L, D)**

- **Breakfast** in the hotel
- Visit **Angkor wat**, the most balanced, the most harmonious, and the most perfect Khmer temple. It shows Khmer art, which reached the height of its glory in the 12<sup>th</sup> century. The temple is a temple-mountain and was built by king Suryavrmn II and dedicated to god Vishnu.
- **Lunch** at local restaurant.
- Afternoon, visit **south gate of Angkor Thom** with two rows of its huge statues of demons and gods depicting the churning of the ocean of milk arranged on both sides of stone bridge and **Bayon** temple, a forest of heads, built in late of 12th century by king Jayavarman VI as a Buddhist state temple. Then, visit **terrace of elephant**, which used to be a base for the king's grand audience hall; **Terrace of Leper king** supposed that it was a terrace housed the royal crematory.
- Climb **Bakheng hill** to have bird's-eye view of sunset, Angkor Wat and western Baray.
- **Dinner** at Local Restaurant.
- Overnight in Siem Reap



**DAY 6: BANTEAY SREI – BIG CIRCUIT**

**(B, L, D)**

- **Breakfast** in the hotel.
- Visit **Banteay Srei** Temple, a tiny temple complex considered by many visitors to be the highest achievement in art and architecture of the Classic Angkor civilization. The glory of Banteay Srei is the beauty of its sculpture and decoration. The pink sandstone used in its buildings makes this temple more beautiful. On the way back to the town you will visit **Banteay Samre**, Built in 12<sup>th</sup> in Angkor wat style.
- **Lunch** at local restaurant
- Afternoon, visit **Pre Rup** temple, a classic example of temple-mountain, and the last without continuous galleries; **Eastern Mebon, Ta som, Neak Pean**, a unique ancient hospital built in the reign of king Jayavarman VI (1181-1220) which has been seen as a representation of Anavatapta, a miraculous lake in Himalayas that cures all illnesses; and **Preah Khan**, a large temple built on the site of battle that ended in Ankor's downfall at the land of the Cham. Preah Khan was also really a kind of university, housing a number of masters and students. Then visit an amazing view of **Ta prohm** Temple which has been deliberately left as it was discovered.
- **Dinner with traditional show** at local restaurant.
- Overnight in Siem Reap



**Day 7: SIEM REAP – PHNOM PENH**

**(B, L, D)**



- **Breakfast** in the hotel.
- Transfer to airport for departure to Phnom Penh.
- Upon arrival Phnom Penh International airport, you will be welcome by tour guide and transfer to hotel for check in.
- Lunch at Local restaurant.
- Afternoon, start visit Start a city tour of some major sights of Phnom Penh. You will visit the **National Museum**, in which there is an attractive collection of ancient Khmer art: The sandstone sculptures dating from both the Angkorean and pre-

Angkorean eras. You will also visit **Royal Palace**, the sacred **Silver Pagoda**, which is well known for its 5000 silver tiled floor. Heading out of this area. You will follow your trip to **Wat Phnom**.

- **Dinner** at Local Restaurant.
- Overnight in Phnom Penh

**Day 8: PHNOM PENH**

**(B, L, D)**

- **Breakfast** at hotel
- After breakfast, you will explore the capital city with the bustling Central Market, the Independence Monument, Wat Ounalom.
- **Lunch** at local restaurant
- Afternoon, we start the trip to the Tuol Sleng Prison Museum and the notorious “Killing Fields” of Choeung Ek, which provides a deep Insight into the painful rule of the Khmer Rouge
- **Dinner** in the Local restaurant.
- Overnight in Phnom Penh
